Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)

The European institutions have approved the so-called 'stop-the-clock' regulation. This means that the introduction of the **Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)** will be postponed by one to two years for many companies:

- Large listed companies will start as planned in 2024.
- Large non-listed companies will only report from 2027 (instead of 2025).
- Listed SMEs will report from 2028 (instead of 2026).
- Non-EU companies with a turnover of more than €150 million in the EU will continue to report from 2028.

The Belgian Council of Ministers has now formally transposed this postponement into national law, making it fully legally binding for Belgian companies. This postponement gives companies extra time to prepare for the new sustainability obligations.

Update on circular letter on safety verifications – PC 226

The updated **circular on safety verifications in PC226** (01/07/2025) completely replaces the previous version of 25/04/2025. This update is in response to changes in the guidelines of the FPS Mobility and Transport (maritime security) and includes, among other things:

- New provisions on decisions and appeal procedures
- Changes relating to the consequences under labour law
- Model clauses for employment contracts (Appendix 4)
- Updated information on port facilities (Appendices 2 and 3)

Q Tip: Make sure your internal procedures and employment contracts are in line with the new regulations.
